Formed at The Juilliard School in 2020 under the mentorship of Roger Tapping & Karoly Schranz of the Takács Quartet, the ensemble made their debut virtually with "Music for Food" under the direction of violist Kim Kashkashian.

Recognized internationally for their emotional performances, Tallā Rouge has been named NOLA ChamberFest's "Emerging Artists" of the year (2022-2023) by the Catalyst Quartet, has been awarded first-prize winner in the Frances Walton Competition, and has been named a top prize winner in the International Anton Rubinstein Chamber Music Competition (2022-2023). Tallā Rouge will be a featured ensemble on the 2023 inaugural American Viola Society album and will make their Carnegie Hall debut as a duo in June of 2023.
